Interventions

The World Health Organization has conducted a five-day works hop on nutrition data management, analysis, interpretation and use, in an effort to strengthen nutrition surveillance and the capacity to implement nutrition interventions in the Ministry of Health and Social Services.

The just concluded works hop was over a 3 day period from 15-18 May 2017 in Windhoek and was attended by 25 participants from all 14 Regions.
