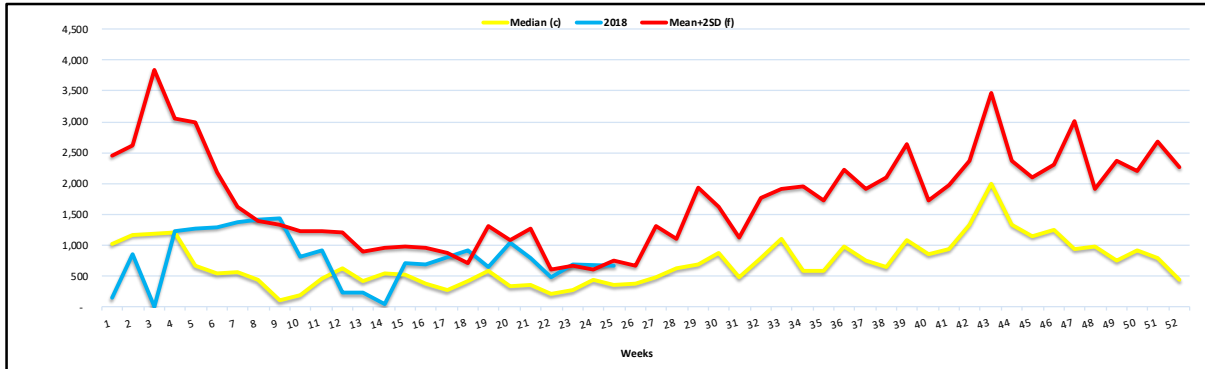


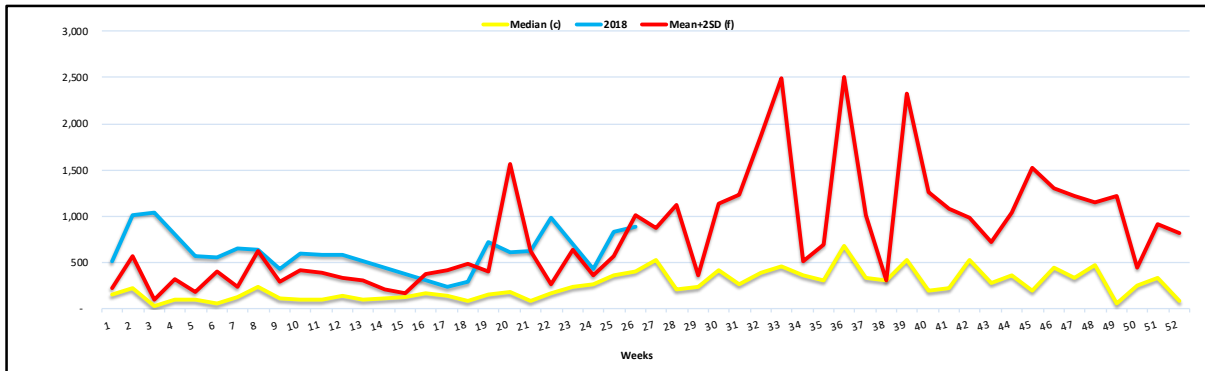
Malaria trends by county Republic of South Sudan, as of week 26, 2018
