# HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (14/12/2020)

- ➤ A total of 16913 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 0.7% of the population.
- ➤ More male cases 9095 (53.8%) were recorded compared to female cases 7818 (46.2%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 702 (4.2%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
  - 470 (67.0%) State; 228 (32.5%) Private, 4 (0.6%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 530 (75.5%) recoveries and 3 (0.4%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 88.6%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 8003 (47.3%) and 4342 (25.7%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 123 (75%) are COVID-19 deaths while 41 (25%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- Since March 2020, 21678 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 845 people are currently in quarantine, with 164 new admissions in the last 24 hours.

- A highest peak of 2123 (12.6%) cases was recorded during week 34 (Figure 1).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (14/12/2020) 1005 calls were answered including 89 alerts.





Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 14 December 2020

As of 14 December 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 11786 (69.7%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 2239 (13.2%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 384 (2.3%) of the total cases whereas, 798 (4.7%) are above 60 years of age.

- To date, 176623 tests (including 7269 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 40482 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 325 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 36914 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 4790 (28.3%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 3830 (100%) out of 3830 active contacts monitored.
