HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (06/01/2021)



- A total of 26682 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 1.1% of the population.
- More male cases 13650 (51.2%) were recorded compared to female cases 13032 (48.8%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1238 (4.6%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
 - 943 (76.2%) State; 291 (23.5%) Private, 4 (0.3%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 960 (77.5%) recoveries and 4 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 84.9%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 12450 (46.7%) and 5845 (21.9%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 193 (80.4%) are COVID-19 deaths while 47 (19.5%) are COVID-19 related deaths.




Figure 1: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 06 January 2021

Table 2: Number of people in mandatory quarantine facilities

- Of the total confirmed cases, 18616 (69.8%) are in the 20-49 years agebrackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 3116 (11.7%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 589 (2.2%) of the total cases whereas, 1578 (5.9%) are above 60 years of age.

- Since March 2020, 25934 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1489 people are currently in quarantine, with 107 new admissions.




Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 06 January 2021

- A highest peak of 3463 (13%) cases was recorded during week 53 (Figure 2).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (06/01/2021) 1183 calls were answered including 93 alerts.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

- To date, 218460 tests (including 9420 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 50554 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 704 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 44162 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 5856 (21.9%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 4385 (71.3%) out of 6149 active contacts monitored.

CHALLENGES

- Lack of isolation units and facilities in the regions.
- Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.
