## HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (23 /12/2020)



- A total of 20579 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 0.8% of the population.
- More male cases 10796 (52.4%) were recorded compared to female cases 9783 (47.5%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 896 (4.4%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
  - 623 (69.5%) State; 269 (30.0%) Private, 4
     (0.5%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 574 (64.1%) recoveries and 3 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 83.6%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 9959 (48.4%) and 4795 (23.3%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 144 (77%) are COVID-19 deaths while 43 (23%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- To date, 193476 tests (including 7752 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 44641 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 401 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 38773 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 5130 (24.9%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- > Today, 5474 (97.0%) out of 5641 active contacts monitored.

- A highest peak of 2178 (10.6%) cases was recorded during week 51 (Figure 1).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (23/12/2020) **831** calls were answered including **76** alerts.





Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 23 December 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 14463 (70.3%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 2542 (12.4%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 445 (2.2%) of the total cases whereas, 1027 (5.0%) are above 60 years of age.

- Since March 2020, 24017 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- > A total of 1465 people are currently in quarantine, with 221 new admissions.
