

- ➤ A total of 23941 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 1% of the population.
- More male cases 12345 (51.6%) were recorded compared to female cases 11596 (48.4%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1046 (4.4%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
 - 767 (73.3%) State; 275 (26.3%) Private, 4 (0.4%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 747 (71.4%) recoveries and 3 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 83.9%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 11520 (48.1%) and 5382 (22.5%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 160 (78%) are COVID-19 deaths while 45 (22%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 30 December 2020

- A highest peak of 3209 (13.4%) cases was recorded during week 52 (Figure 1).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (30/12/2020) 846 calls were answered including 102 alerts.

- To date, 206846 tests (including 8589 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 47396 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 689 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 10 regions.
- Cumulatively, 40865 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 5476 (22.9%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 4486 (72.7%) out of 6167 active contacts monitored.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 30 December 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 16786 (70.1%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 2853 (11.9%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 521 (2.2%) of the total cases whereas, 1309 (5.5%) are above 60 years of age.
