

- A total of 33265 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 1% of the population.
- More male cases 16796 (50%) were recorded compared to female cases 16469 (50%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1581 (5%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
 - 1208 (76%) State; 369 (23%) Private, 4 (0.3%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1238 (78%) recoveries and 6 (0.4%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 94%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 14161 (43%) and 6818 (20%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 273 (82%) are COVID-19 deaths while 59 (18%) are COVID-19 related deaths.



- To date, 256971 tests (including 11182 retests) have been conducted by NiP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 60175 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 383 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 13 regions.
- Cumulatively, 54472 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 7525 (23%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 4427 (69%) out of 5604 active contacts monitored.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 22884 (69%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **3970** (**12%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 774 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2120 (6%) are above 60 years of age.

A highest peak of 3485 (10%) cases was recorded during week 54 (Figure 2).

The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.

Today (26/01/2021), **656** calls were answered including **70** alerts.

- Since March 2020, 30586 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1271 people are currently in quarantine, with 152 new admissions.

- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- > The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

- Lack of isolation units and facilities in the regions.
- Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities throughout the country.
- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
