# Death 2

- The number of cases continue to flare up from the various schools among learners and teachers.
- A total of **35952** cases have been recorded to-date, representing **1%** of the population.
- More male cases 18274 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 17678 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1681 (5%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
  - > 1293 (77%) State; 380 (23%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - > 1598 (95%) recoveries and 6 (0.4%) deaths.
- > The recovery rate now stands at 95%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 14796 (41%) and 7208 (20%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 312 (80%) are COVID-19 deaths while 76 (20%) are COVID-19 related deaths.



- Since March 2020, 33070 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1441 people are currently in quarantine, with 192 new admissions.

A highest peak of 3485 (10%) cases was recorded during week 53 (Figure 1).

The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.

Today (13/02/2021), **598** calls were answered including **75** alerts.

As of 13 February 2021




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 13 February 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 24514 (68%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 4484 (12%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 835 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2322 (6%) are above 60 years of age.

- To date, 279999 tests (including 11425 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 65272 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 55 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 8 regions.
- Cumulatively, 60709 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 8357 (23%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 5 (0.1%) out of 4041 active contacts monitored.

### **PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)**

- Mechanisms are underway on how to roll out the vaccine nationwide once it is made available.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

#### **CHALLENGES**

Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
