- ➤ A total of 36225 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 1% of the population.
- More male cases 18357 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 17868 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1683 (5%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
 - > 1294 (77%) State; 381 (23%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - > 1598 (95%) recoveries and 6 (0.4%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 97%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 14817 (42%) and 7216 (20%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 312 (80%) are COVID-19 deaths while 77 (20%) are COVID-19 related deaths.



- Since March 2020, 33087 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1360 people are currently in quarantine, with 17 new admissions.

A highest peak of 3485 (10%) cases was recorded during week 53 (Figure 1).

The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.

Today (14/02/2021), 598 calls were answered including 75 alerts.

Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 14 February 2021




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 14 February 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 24590 (68%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 4462 (13%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- ➤ The under 5 years age group make 840 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2328 (6%) are above 60 years of age.

- To date, 281543 tests (including 11433 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 65597 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 325 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 13 regions.
- Cumulatively, 60815 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 8360 (23%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 1527 (36%) out of 4288 active contacts monitored.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Mechanisms are underway on how to roll out the vaccine nationwide once it is made available.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
