# **HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (25/02/2021)**

- A total of 38424 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- More male cases 19526 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 18898 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1748 (5%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
  - 1351 (77%) State; 389 (22%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 1648 (94%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 94%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 15158 (39%) and 7411 (19%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 330 (79%) are COVID-19 deaths while 88 (21%) are COVID-19 related deaths.



As of 13 March 2020 to 25 February 2021

A highest peak of 3485 (9%) cases was recorded during week 54 (Figure 1).

The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.

Today (25/02/2021), 597 calls were answered including 71 alerts.




Figure 2: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, As of 25 February 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 25546 (66%) are in the 20-49 years agebrackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 5591 (15%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- > The under 5 years age group make 878 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2408 (6%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 25 February 2021

- To date, 296956 tests (including 11523 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 69611 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 518 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 65245 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 9342 (24%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 2428 (62%) out of 3899 active contacts monitored.

Table 3: Number of people in mandatory quarantine facilities, 25 February 2021

- Since March 2020, 35675 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 2099 people are currently in quarantine, with 298 new admissions.
