


HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (07/03/2021)

- A total of 40187 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- More male cases 20337 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 19850 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1809 (5%) are Health Workers (HWs).
 - 1409 (78%) State; 396 (22%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1686 (93%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 94%.



- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 15507 (39%) and 7540 (19%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 348 (79%) are COVID-19 deaths while 91 (21%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 26334 (66%) are in the 20-49 years agebrackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **6272** (**16%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 910 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2523 (6%) are above 60 years of age.



- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 72251 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 263 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 10 regions.
- Cumulatively, 67489 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 9817 (24%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 190 (4%) out of 4345 active contacts monitored.




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 07 March 2021

RECOMMENDATIONS


Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
