

- Today, Honourable Minister of Health and Social Services launched a national COVID-19 vaccination programme in Windhoek.
- ➤ A total of 42203 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- More male cases 21317 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 20886 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1891 (4%) are Health Workers (HWs).
 - 1484 (78%) State; 403 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%)
 Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1749 (92%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 93%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases;
 Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with
 15915 (38%) and 7763 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 396 (80%) are COVID-19 deaths while 96 (20%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 27358 (65%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
 - A total of 6860 (16%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
 - The under 5 years age group make up 961 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2671 (6%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases
19 March 2021




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 19 March 2021

- To date, 328367 tests (including 11705 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 76861 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 421 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 10 regions.
- Cumulatively, 71775 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 10464 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 2008 (41%) out of 4844 active contacts monitored.
