# CUMULATIVE TOTAL TODAY Tested 350793 Tested 1406 Confirmed 45008 Confirmed 122 Active 1815 Active 1815 Recoveries 42641 Recoveries 283 Deaths 542 Deaths 4

- A total of 45008 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1974 (4%) are Health Workers.
  - 1552 (79%) State; 418 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 1941 (98%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 95%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 16409 (36%) and 8066 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 440 (81%) are COVID-19 deaths while 102 (19%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

# **EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION IN NAMIBIA**




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 05 April 2021

- A highest peak of 3485 (8%) cases was recorded during week 1 in 2021 (Figure 1).
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (05/04/2021), 470 calls were answered including 18 alerts.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 05 April 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 28695 (64%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 7734 (17%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1027 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2870 (6%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 05 April 2021

- To date, 350793 tests (including 11791 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology and Central Veterinary laboratories
- ➤ Since the beginning of the outbreak, 81457 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 175 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 76870 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 11431 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 1052 (25%) out of 4195 active contacts monitored.

- A total of 1297 people are currently in quarantine, with 11 new admissions.

- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
