HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (12/04/2021)

- A total of 45949 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1994 (4%) are Health Workers.
 - 1570 (79%) State; 420 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1941 (97%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 96%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 16564 (36%) and 8234 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 477 (81%) are COVID-19 deaths while 109 (19%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION IN NAMIBIA




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 12 April 2021

- A highest peak of 3485 (8%) cases was recorded during week 1 in 2021 (Figure 1).
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (12/04/2021), 538 calls were answered including 21 alerts.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 12 April 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 29149 (63%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 8016 (17%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1050 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2942 (2%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 12 April 2021

- To date, 361593 tests (including 11837 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 83724 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 120 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 13 regions.
- Cumulatively, 78957 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 11684 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 2562 (65%) out of 3949 active contacts monitored.

- Since March 2020, 42849 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1425 people are currently in quarantine, with 185 new admissions.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION (S)

> The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise the continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

- Lack of isolation units and facilities for cases detected in boarding schools and police holding cells.
- Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for cases detected in schools and police holding cells.
- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.


