➤ A total of 46051 cases have been recorded to-date. r	representing 2% of the population

- A total of 46051 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1997 (4%) are Health Workers.
 - 1571 (79%) State; 422 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1941 (97%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 96%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 16615 (36%) and 8250 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 481 (81%) are COVID-19 deaths while 111 (19%) are COVID-19 related deaths.




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 13 April 2021

- A highest peak of 3485 (8%) cases was recorded during week 1 in 2021 (Figure 1).
- ➤ The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (13/04/2021), 499 calls were answered including 27 alerts.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 13 April 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 29220 (63%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 8033 (17%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1050 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2950 (2%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 13 April 2021

- To date, 362700 tests (including 11843 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 84061 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 337 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 79267 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 11685 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 2768 (70%) out of 3976 active contacts monitored.

- A total of 1517 people are currently in quarantine, with 233 new admissions.

- Lack of isolation units and facilities for cases detected in boarding schools and police holding cells.
- Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for cases detected in schools and police holding cells.
- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
