- A total of 49151 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 2115 (4%) are Health Workers.
 - 1664 (79%) State; 447 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 2064 (98%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 95%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 17371 (35%) and 8680 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 539 (82%) are COVID-19 deaths while 120 (18%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- To date, 389362 tests (including 11936 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology, Highcare and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 89138 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified,
 465 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 10 regions.
- Cumulatively, 84326 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 12453 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 447 (11%) out of 4078 active contacts monitored.




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 02 May 2021

- The highest peaks of 3463 (7%) and 3485 (7%) cases were recorded during week 53 of 2020 and 1 of 2021 respectively (Figure 1).
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (02/05/2021), 389 calls were answered including 12 alerts.

- Since March 2020, 45479 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1268 people are currently in quarantine, with 33 new admissions.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 30884 (63%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 8709 (18%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1114 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 3261 (7%) are above 60 years of age.





Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases

Cumulative_ confirmed cases per 100 000 people




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 02 May 2021
