# **HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (04/09/2021)**

- A total of 125 659 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 5% of the total population (2 550 226).
- More female cases 66 731 (53%) have been recorded.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 4 281 (3%) are Health Workers.
  - 3 564 (83%) State; 709 (17%) Private, 8 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 4 233 (99%) recoveries and 25 (0.6%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 95%.
- Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest number of cases with 41 406 (33%) and 18 158 (15%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 3 129 (92%) are COVID-19 deaths while 281 (8%) are COVID-19 related deaths. The case fatality rate now stands at 2.7%.

## **EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION IN NAMIBIA**




Figure 1: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 04 September 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 74852 (60%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 20 542 (16%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- A total of 14 943 (12%) of the confirmed cases are among the 50 59 years group.
- The under 5 years age group make up 2 815 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 12 507 (10%) are above 60 years of age.

- The laboratory testing capacity has been enhanced; with a total of fifteen (15) laboratories carrying out the testing of samples: NIP, Path-Care, UNAM Molecular, Central Veterinary Laboratory, Namib Poultry, NAMDEB, NamPath, Namibia Central Pathology, DiagnoLab, High Care, Alpha Medical Laboratory, Des-Jo Medical Test Centre, ProQuest Diagnostic Laboratory, MAXI and Medlink Laboratory Services.
- To date, 668 672 tests (including 14 150 re-tests) have been conducted by authorized laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 139 949 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 91 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 7 regions.
- Cumulatively, 136 730 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while 288 contacts are lost to follow-up and a total of 24 694 (20%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 142 (19%) out of 1 776 active contacts were monitored.




Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 04 September 2021

- The highest peak of 12 787 (10%) cases was recorded during week 25 of 2021 (Figure 2).
- After a peak in epi-week 25, the country has seen a gradual reduction in the average number of confirmed cases to 144 in epi-week 34.
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (04/09/2021), 498 calls were answered including 7 alerts.

- Since March 2020, 75 456 people have been placed into quarantine around the country.
- A total of 1 409 people are currently in quarantine, with 42 admissions.

- A total of Fifteen thousand (15 000) doses of Sputnik V Vaccines have been received as a donation from the Government of the Republic of Serbia; the public shall be informed on when the vaccine will be rolled-out.
- > Public Health measures continues to be enforced as the situation is closely monitored.
- The COVID-19 vaccination programme is ongoing throughout the country
- The government and development partners continue to prioritize the continuation of essential health services.
