

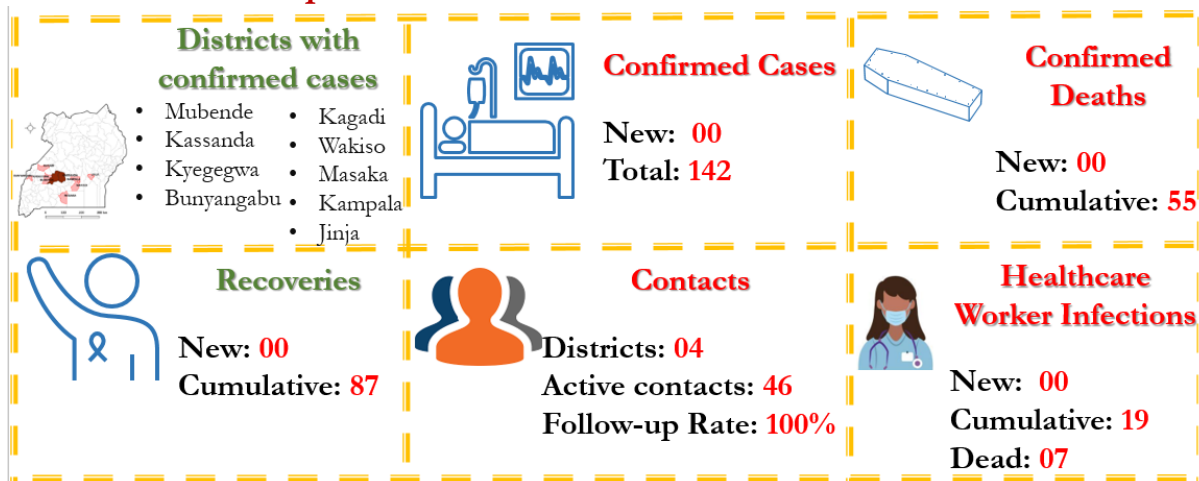
# EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE

## Republic of Uganda



### Situation Report 68

Data update as of 04<sup>th</sup> December 2022 at 22 :00 HRS



### Highlights

- Today marks 79 days of responding to the EVD outbreak, and 04 days since the last confirmed case.
- Within the past 24 hours, there was no new confirmed case, no deaths or recoveries.
- However, following a data reconciliation exercise between case management and surveillance, one case previously classified as 'dead' is re-classified as 'recovered'.
- Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) among confirmed cases still stands 55/142 (39%).
- A total of 46 contacts actively being followed-up in four districts, follow-up rate in the past 24 hours was 100%.

## Key messages to the public

- People in the community should call an alert hotline or go to a health facility if they have symptoms (e.g., fever, headache, weakness, vomiting, bloody diarrhoea or urine, bleeding from body openings).

- Free alert SMS on **6767** starting with the ‘ALERT’ key word; Free alert SMS to U-report on 8500
- Community should not fear people who have been discharged from the ETU and returned home.
