

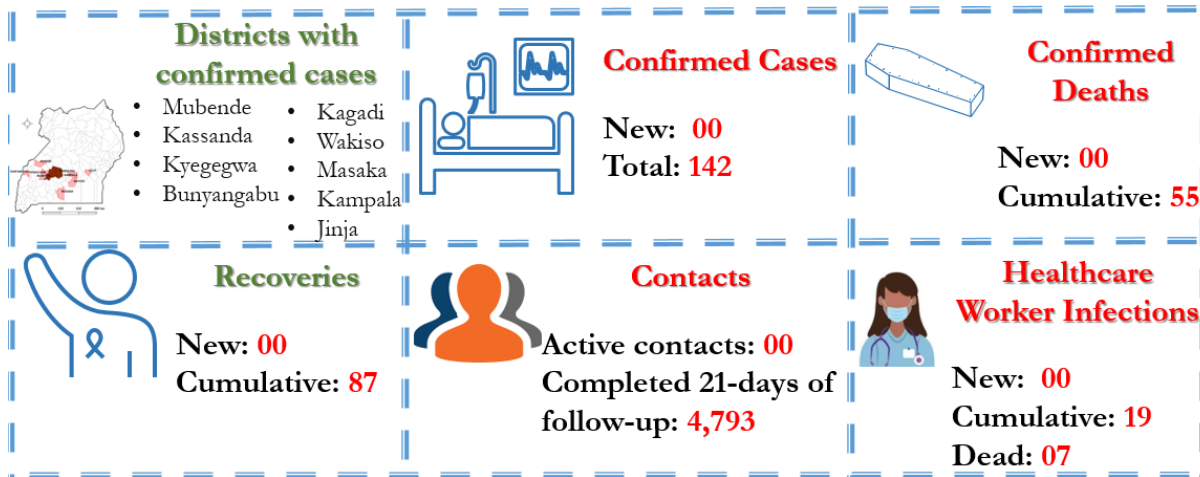

Data update as of 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2022 at 22 :00 HRS



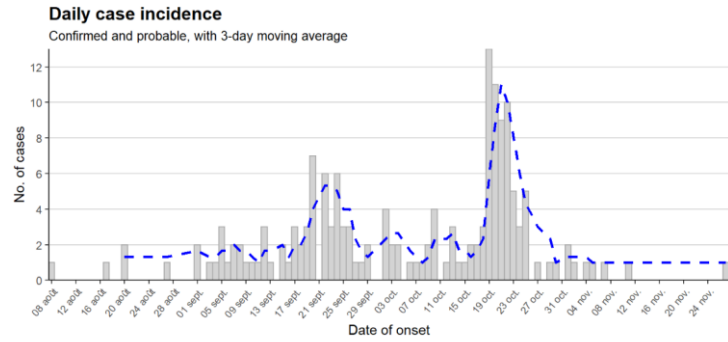
### Background

On 20<sup>th</sup> September 2022, the Ministry of Health declared an outbreak of Sudan Ebola Virus (SVD) after a case managed at Mubende Regional Referral Hospital (MRRH) in Mubende district was confirmed through testing at the Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI). This followed investigations by the National Rapid Response Team of suspicious deaths that had occurred in the district earlier in the month. This is the first time in more than a decade that Uganda reports an outbreak of Sudan ebolavirus

## Key Highlights

Today marks 98 days of responding to the EVD outbreak and 26 days since the last confirmed case.

- ➔ Within the past 24 hours, there was no new confirmed case or death registered; there was no recovery.
- ➔ Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) among confirmed cases still stands 55/142 (39%).
- ➔ No active contacts are currently under follow-up.

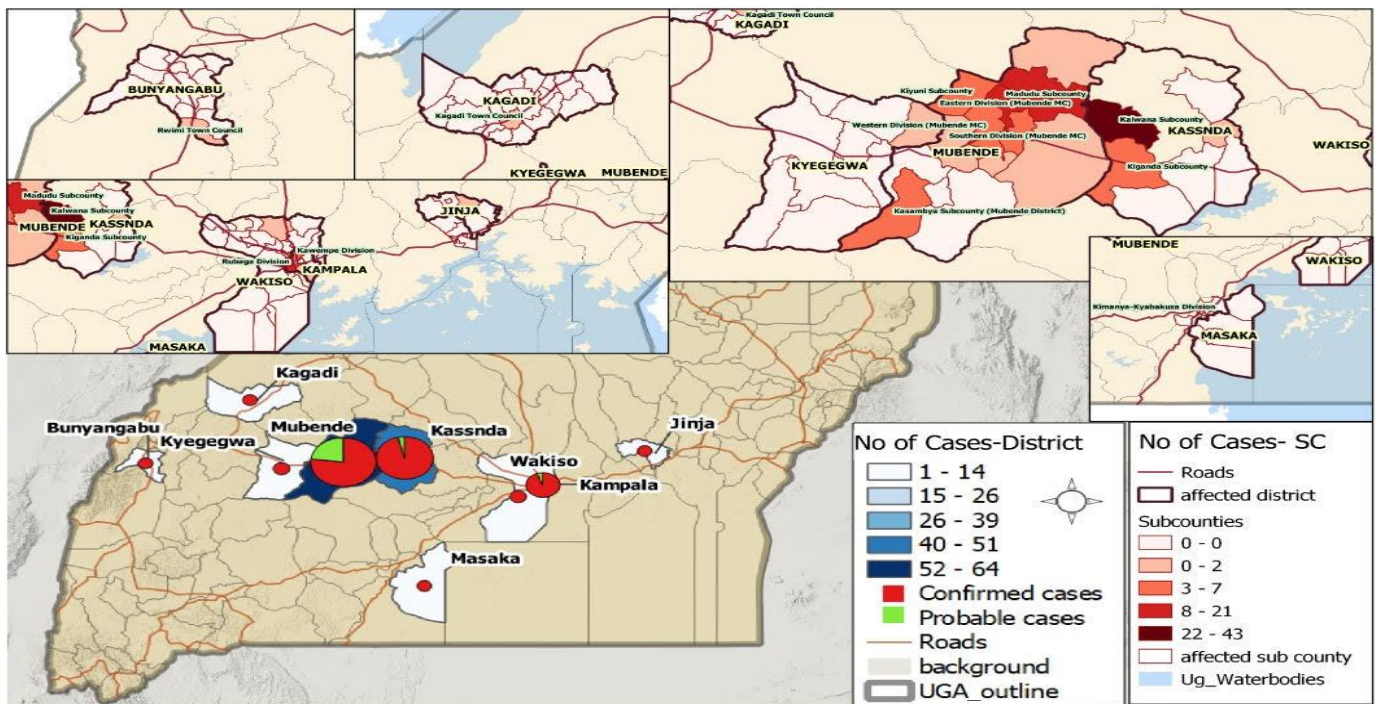

### Actions to date

The Ministry of Health (MoH), Districts, and partners in Uganda are implementing several outbreak control interventions in Mubende and other affected districts to contain the disease spread. An overview of key activities is summarized below:

#### Response Pillar

#### Key Updates in the past 24 hours

Coordination	➔ Regular District Task Force meetings are ongoing in all affected districts
	➔ The bi-weekly National Task Force meetings will resume on 6 <sup>th</sup> January 2023.
	➔ Plans for de-escalation of response activities undergoing in all affected districts.
Surveillance & Contact tracing	➔ No active contacts are currently under follow-up.
	➔ Total alerts validated in the past 24 hours were 26 from Mubende, Kassanda and Masaka districts; five met the suspected case definition.
	➔ A total of 17,131 people were screened at seven national Points of Entry (PoEs), and none met the suspected case definition. EVD information was provided to 1,060 people at these PoEs..
Laboratory	➔ Total of 44 samples were processed at UVRI and the mobile labs in Kampala and Mubende within the past 24-hrs; the average number of samples processed daily within the past seven days stands at 42.
	➔ Cumulative samples tested are 5,472 with 142 people testing POSITIVE for EVD (SUD)
Case Management	➔ Zero confirmed cases on admission currently, routine patient care services ongoing.
	➔ Four beds were occupied in suspected wards in the past 24 hours; three in Madudu and one in the New ETU.
Safe & Dignified Burials	➔ Within the past 24 hours, a total of 11 death alerts were verified from Mubende, Masaka and Kassanda.
	➔ No backlog cases in the past 24 hours.
	➔ Cumulative SDBs conducted in Mubende: 441, Kassanda: 344, and eight in Jinja
Risk Communication & Public Awareness	➔ At least 147 radio spots/messages continue to be aired daily through 10 radio stations: Kyegegwa (08), Kagadi (06), Kassanda (10), Kakumiro (10), Mubende (39), Masaka (13), Sembabule (13), Kazo (20), Kabarole (22) and Jinja.
	➔ A total of 36 radio spots run on 12 CATs in Masaka City and District.
	➔ Conducted one radio talk show on EVD in Kassanda District.
Social Mobilisation	➔ A total of 150 EVD Posters, 9000 factsheets, 50 Job aides, and 40 Q&A booklets were disseminated to the stakeholders engaged in Kyegegwa, and Kassanda, districts
	➔ RCCE team in Jinja distributed 120 EVD Materials.
	➔ Team Kassanda held a dialogue meeting with 10 cultural leaders of Myanzi Sub-county.
	➔ Team Kyegegwa conducted nine community dialogues in Hapuyo Sub-county (4) and Ruyonza (5) engaging a total of 270 parish leaders.
	➔ Team Jinja conducted orientation meetings with born-again pastors and reached 36 individuals.
Stakeholder Engagement	➔ Conducted community drives in Kakabara, Hapuyo, Mpara, Kyegegwa Town council, Kyegegwa, and Bukerere Sub-counties.

## Key messages to the public

- ➔ People in the community should call an alert hotline or go to a health facility if they have symptoms (e.g., fever, headache, weakness, vomiting, bloody diarrhoea or urine, bleeding from body openings).
- ➔ Hotline numbers are: **0800200043** for Mubende and Kassanda; **0800299000** for Kampala Metropolitan Area, **0800300043** for Masaka, **0800355411** for Kagadi all toll-free, **0800300046** for Jinja, and **0787437139** for Bunyangabu (not toll-free).
- ➔ Free alert SMS on **6767** starting with the ‘ALERT’ key word; Free alert SMS to U-report on 8500
- ➔ Community should not fear people who have been discharged from the ETU and returned home.
