

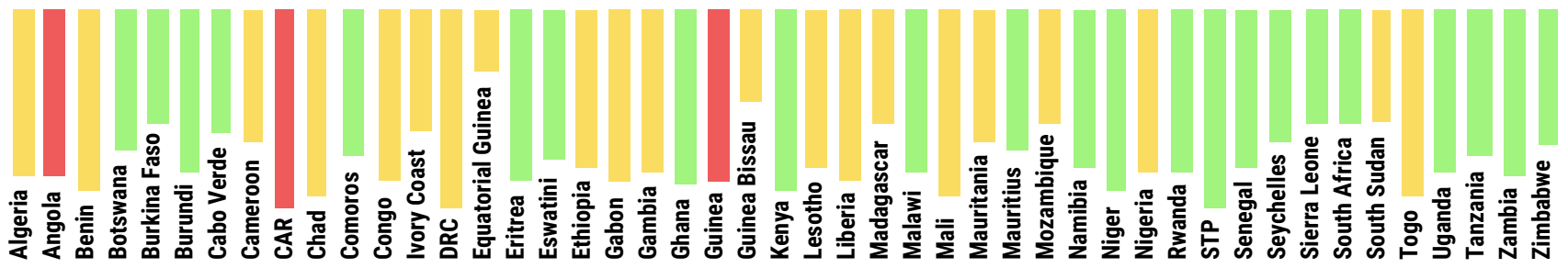

Routine Immunization WHO/UNICEF Estimates - OPV3 (Jan - Dec 2022)

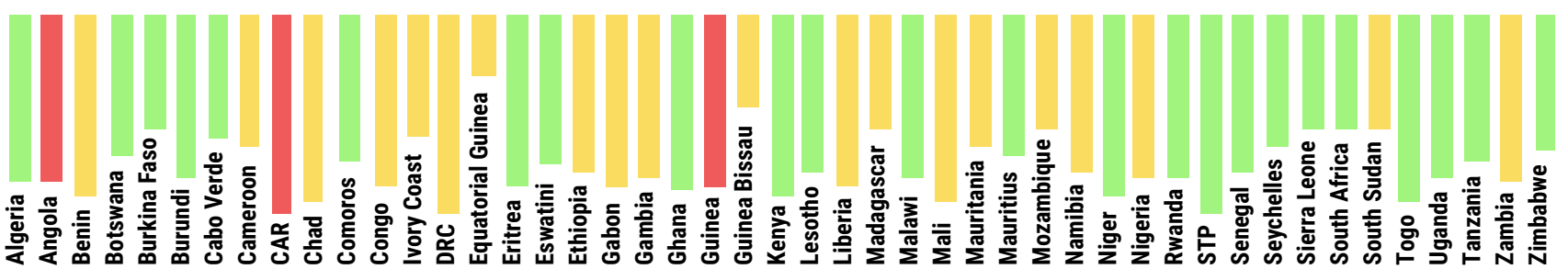

Routine Immunization WHO/UNICEF Estimates - IPV (Jan- Dec 2022)

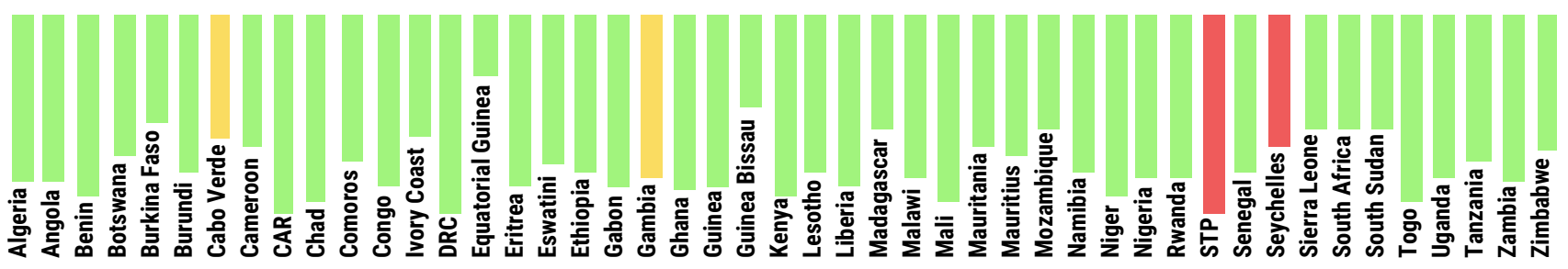

Countries meeting NP AFP rate of $\geq 2/100\ 000$ under 15 y.o (Jan - Dec 2023)

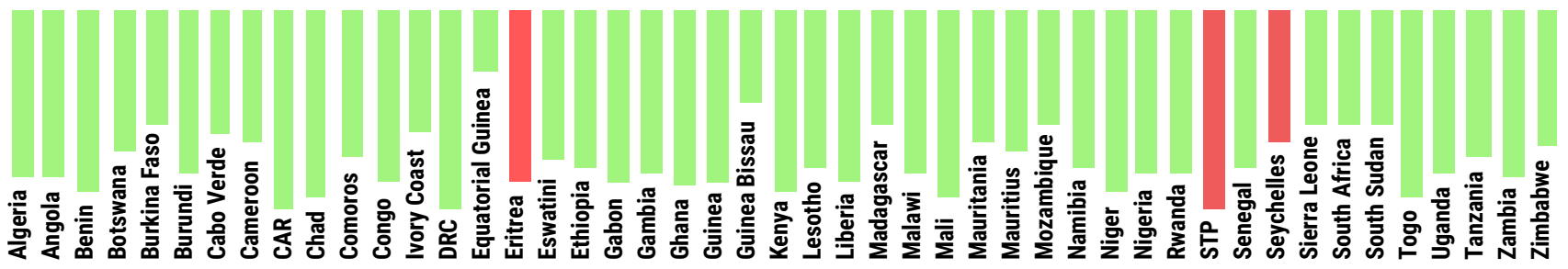

Countries meeting Stool adequacy rate $\geq 80\%$ (Jan - Sept 2023)

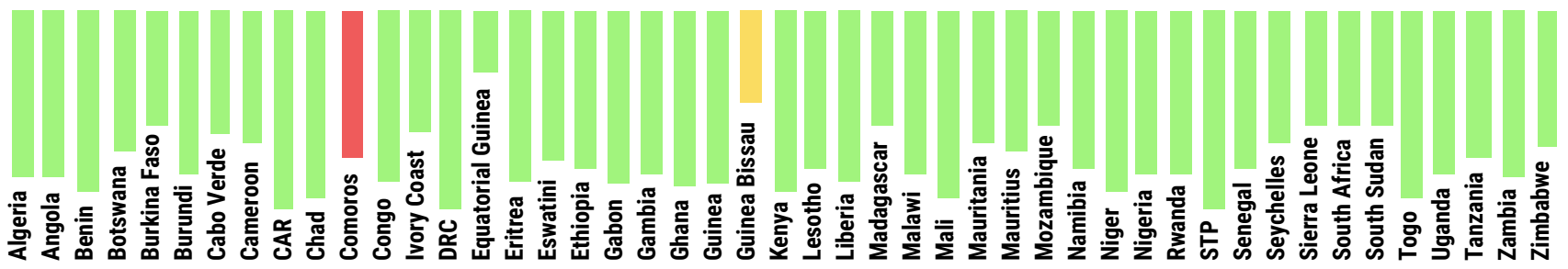

Environmental Surveillance performance

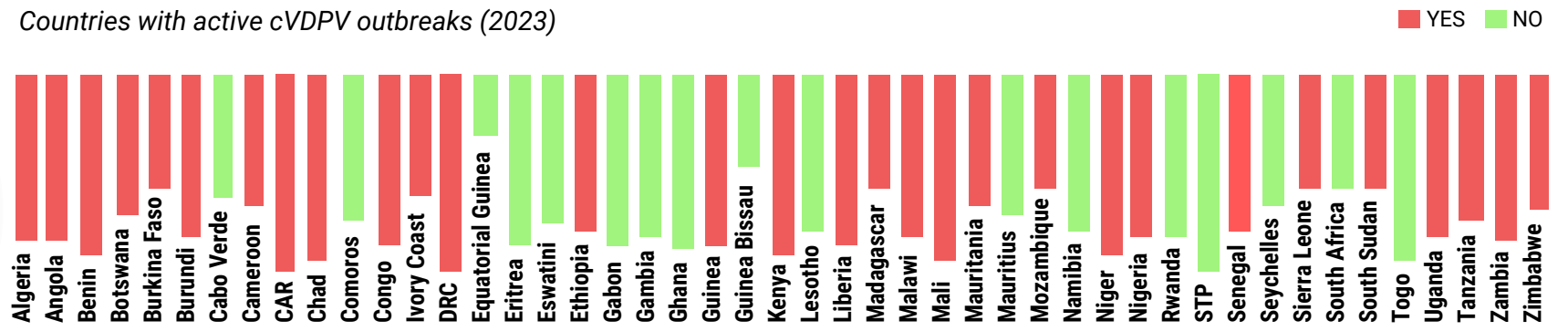
Countries with functional environmental surveillance sites

Countries with active cVDPV outbreaks (2023)



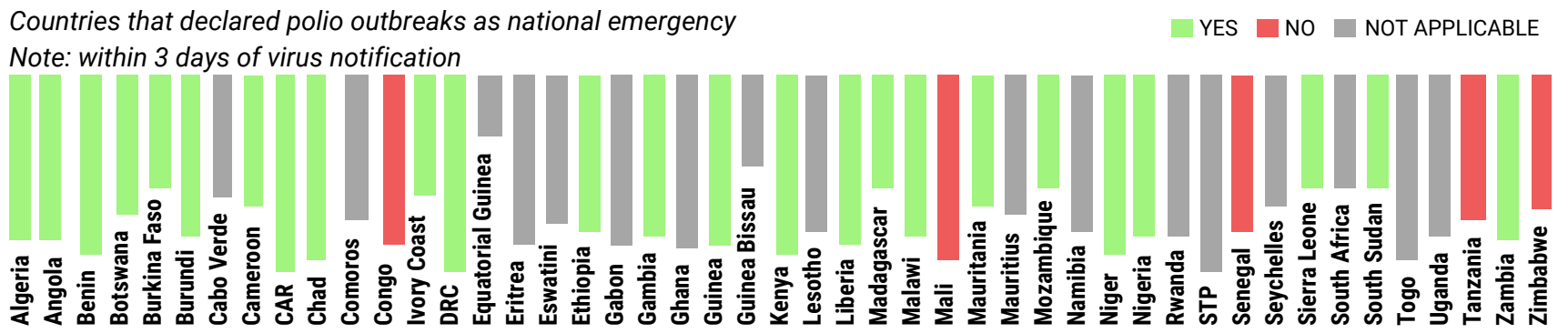
Outbreak Response Immunization Campaign Quality

Note: using lot quality assurance sampling (LQAS)



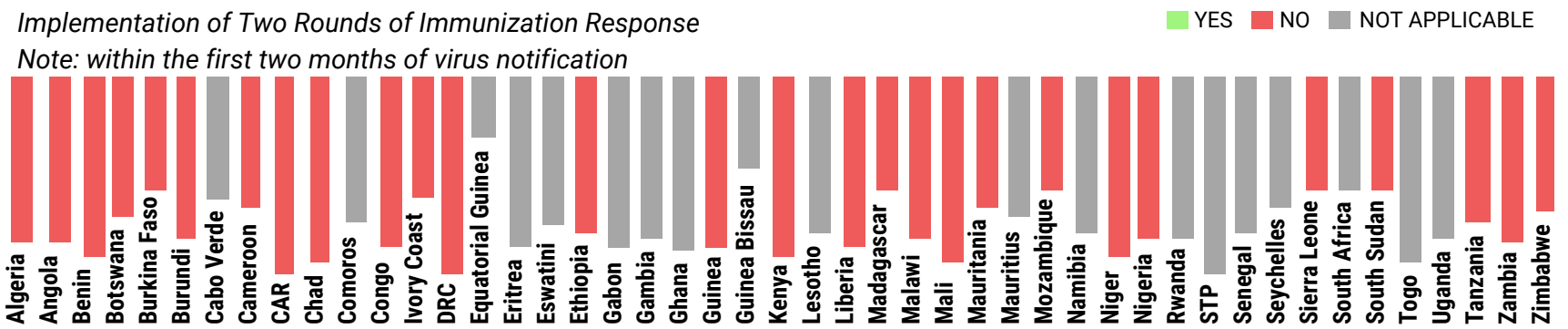
Implementing IHR (2005) during poliovirus outbreaks (PHE Declaration)
