



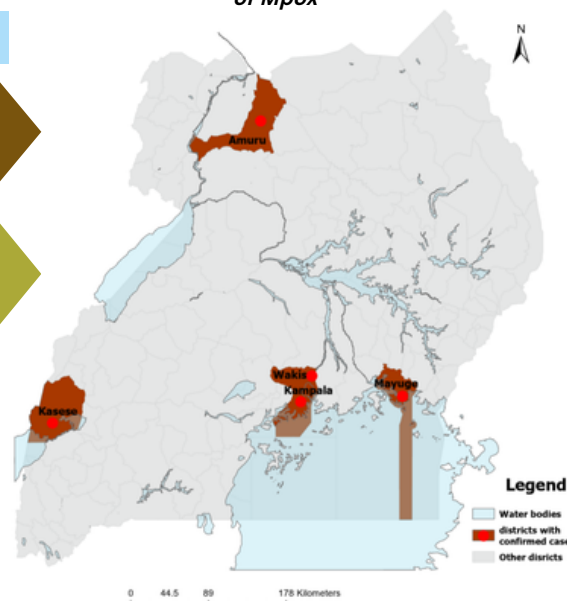
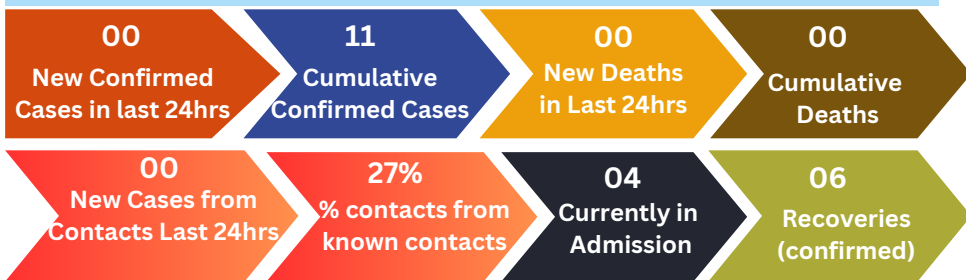

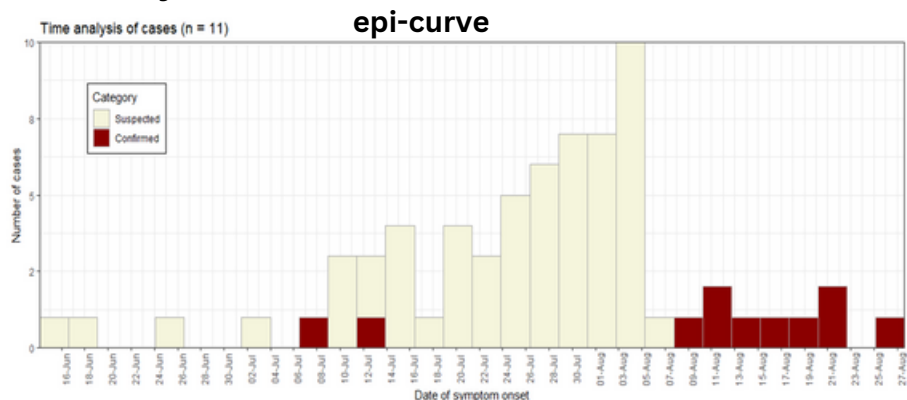

HIGHLIGHTS



Time analysis of affected individuals (n = 11)



- No new cases reported confirmed in the past 24 hours
- The cumulative total confirmed Mpox case since the declaration of the outbreak are 11 (eleven).
- No death has been registered among the confirmed cases.
- Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) is at 00/11 (0.0%).
