


Mpox Outbreak in Uganda


SITUATION Update - 17 October 2024





- Seventeen new confirmed cases reported in the past 24 hours. These are yet to be moved to the treatment unit.
- · No death has been registered among the confirmed cases.
- Cumulatively, 145 confirmed cases of Mpox registered, Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) is 0.0%
- Treatment units with active admissions are in the districts of Nakasongola, Wakiso, Mayuge, Nakaseke, Isingiro, Kabale, Buliisa, Dokolo, Adjumani, and Mbarara
