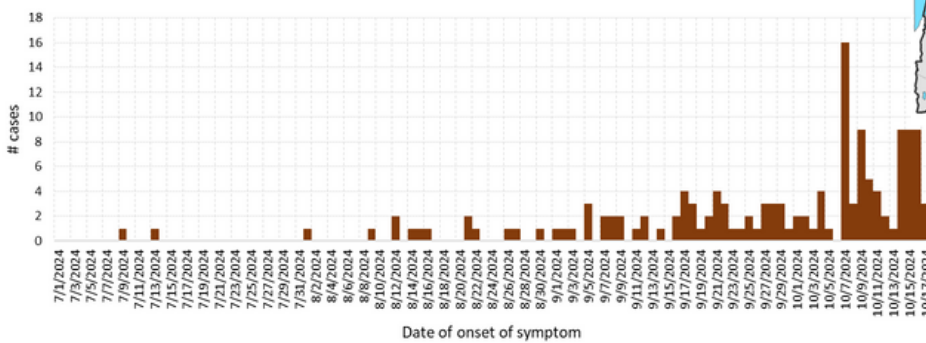

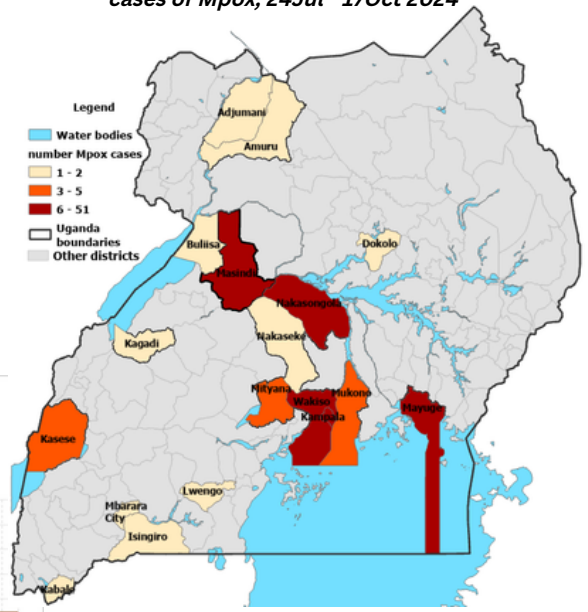

Map of Uganda highlighting districts with confirmed cases of Mpox, 24Jul - 17Oct 2024

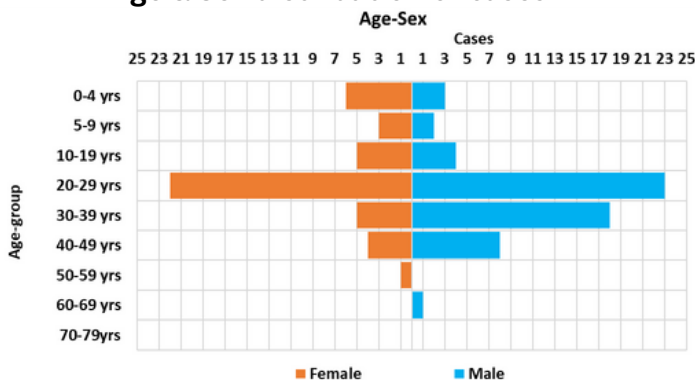


There are 19 districts with Confirmed Cases of Mpox

- Seventeen new confirmed cases reported in the past 24 hours. These are yet to be moved to the treatment unit.
- No death has been registered among the confirmed cases.
- Cumulatively, 145 confirmed cases of Mpox registered, Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) is 0.0%
- Treatment units with active admissions are in the districts of Nakasongola, Wakiso, Mayuge, Nakaseke, Isingiro, Kabale, Buliisa, Dokolo, Adjumani, and Mbarara
