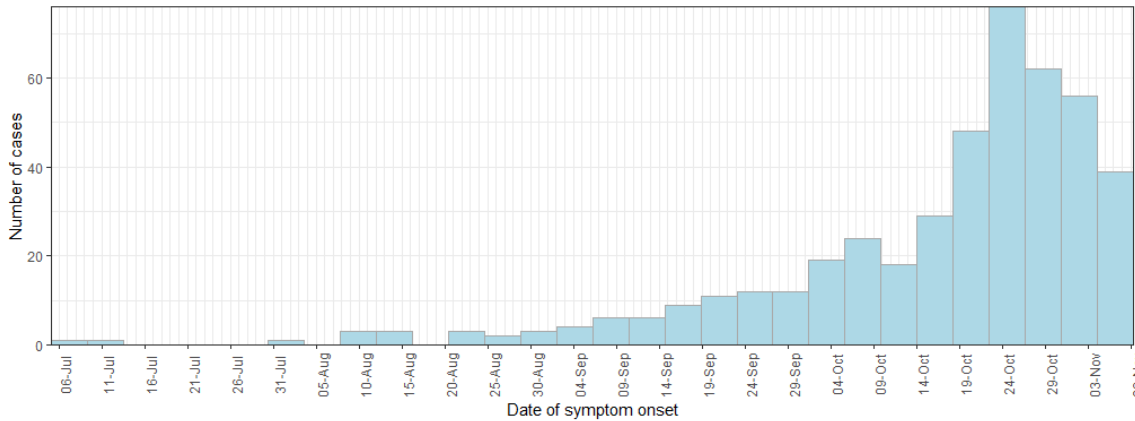

Time analysis of cases (n = 448)



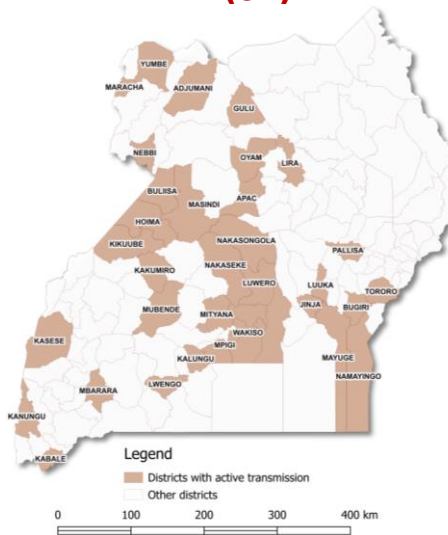
## Key Highlights

- **111** days since the start of the outbreak
- Males **56%** are more affected
- Working age adults (19-49) years are the most hit **65%**
- The Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area accounts for majority of the cases **61%**
- Apac and Oyam districts report an Mpox case for the first time

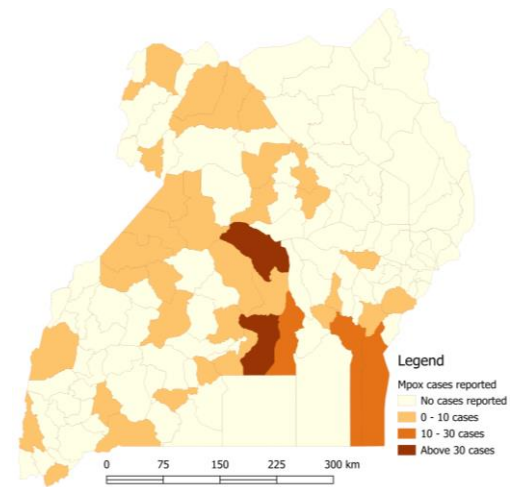
Affected districts **(38)**

## Major activities

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday)
2. Testing of contacts and suspects
3. Preparations for super spreader events are still ongoing (NyegeNyege)
4. Review of the Mpox response plan
5. First Mpox case management community of practice was held
6. Completed the training of health workers in refugee camps
7. Assessments for isolation units completed at MNRH and Mukono GH
