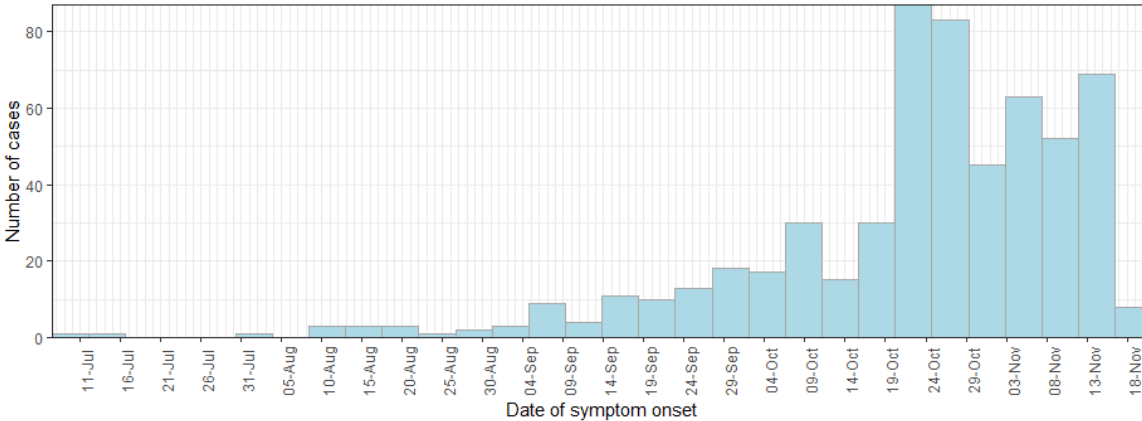

Time analysis of cases (n = 582)



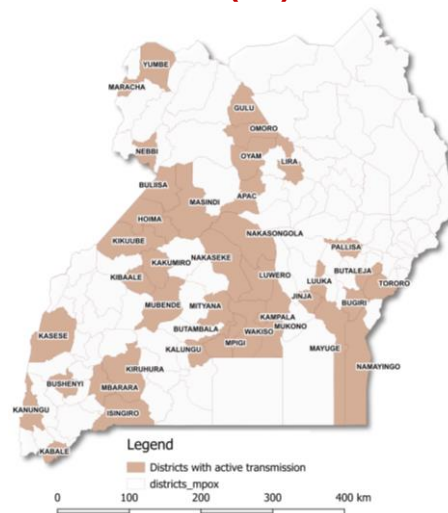
Key Highlights

- **118** days since the start of the outbreak
- Districts reporting new cases; Kampala (**14**), Jinja City (**02**), Kakumiro (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **56%**
- The age group (19-39yrs) are the most affected **58%**
- GKMA contributes **62%** of the total case load
- One new death; CFR **0.3%**

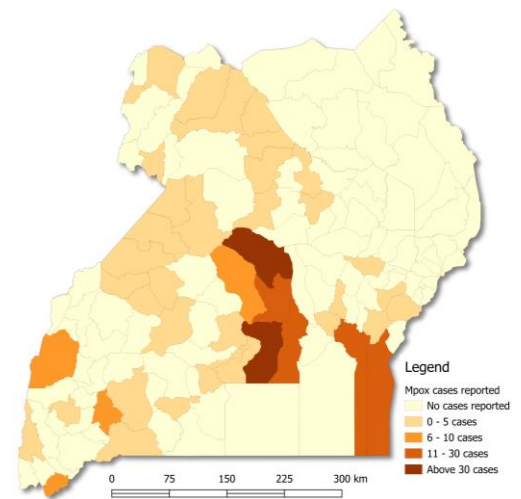
Affected districts (**45**)

Major activities

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday).
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday).
3. Pillar specific meetings continue to happen weekly
4. Case investigations are being conducted for all positive cases
5. A TOT on assessment tools for Surveillance, Clinical care, and IPC was completed
6. A cascade plan for integrated support supervision had been developed by the case management team
7. Case management bi-weekly webinars continue to happen
