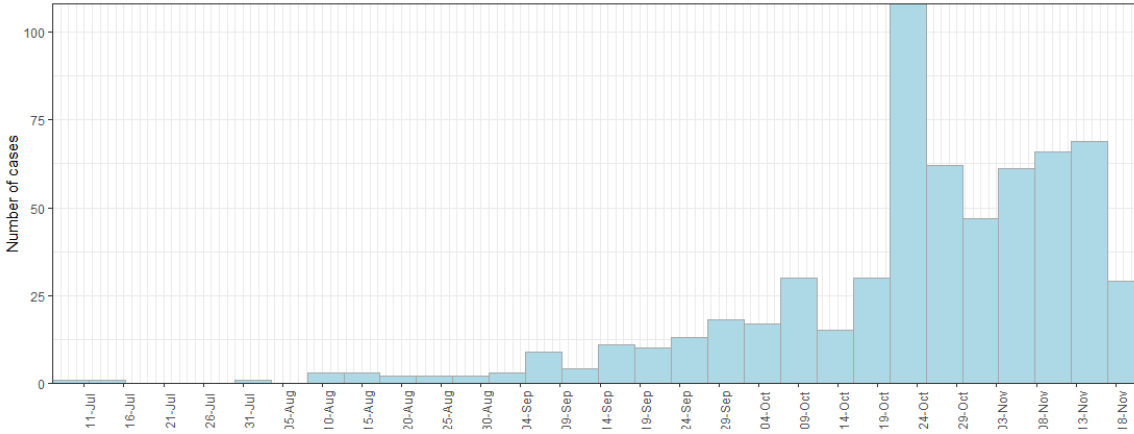

Time analysis of cases (n = 617)



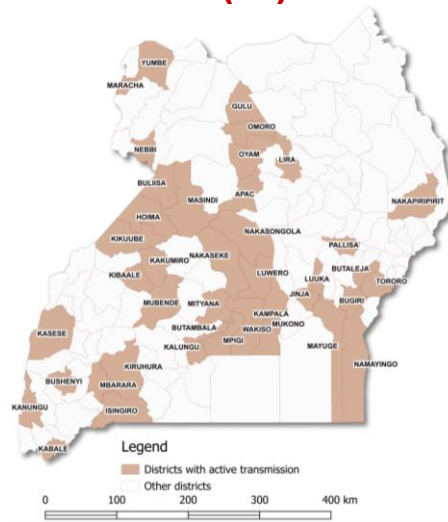
Key Highlights

- **119** days since the start of the outbreak
- Districts reporting new cases; Kampala (**21**), Wakiso (**08**), Mityana (**05**), Mbarara (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **55%**
- Adults (19-39) are the most affected **58%**
- GKMA contributes **63%** of the total case load
- One new death; CFR **0.3%**

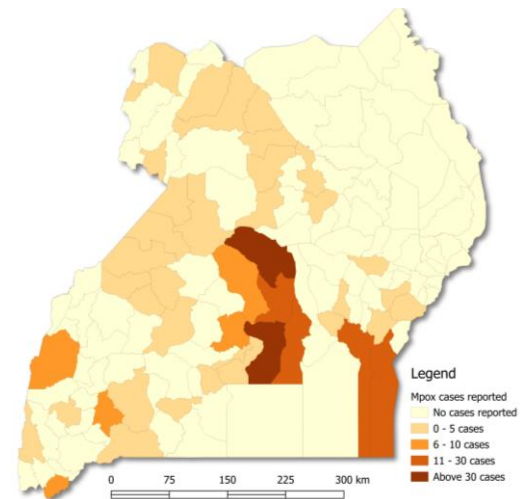

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday).
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday).
3. Pillar specific meetings continue to happen weekly
4. Case investigations are being conducted for all positive cases
5. Case management bi-weekly webinars continue to happen
6. Admission capacity had been expanded in Nakasongola
7. The process for designating Cyanika, Arua airfield, Suam, and Goli POEs is underway
8. Logistics working on reducing lead time for commodities
9. Activation of e-LMIS is under way.
