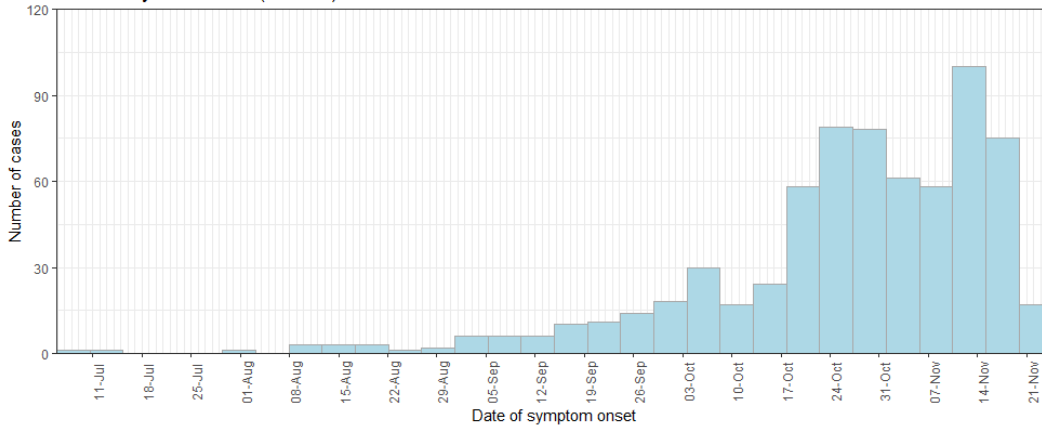

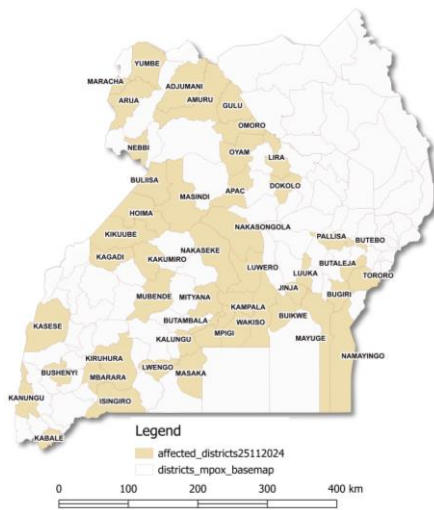
Key Highlights

- **123** days since the start of the outbreak
- Districts reporting new cases; Kampala (**19**), Wakiso (**03**), Kanungu (**02**), Nakasongola (**02**), Buikwe (**02**), Masaka (**01**), Butambala (**01**), Gulu (**01**), Butebo (**01**), Kiruhura (**01**), Arua (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **56%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **59%**
- GKMA contributes **63%** of the total case load
- CFR **0.3%**
- Butebo, Buikwe, Arua, Masaka districts have reported cases for the first time

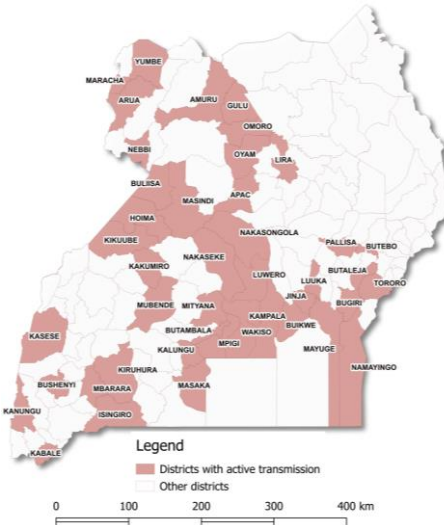
Time analysis of cases (n = 683)



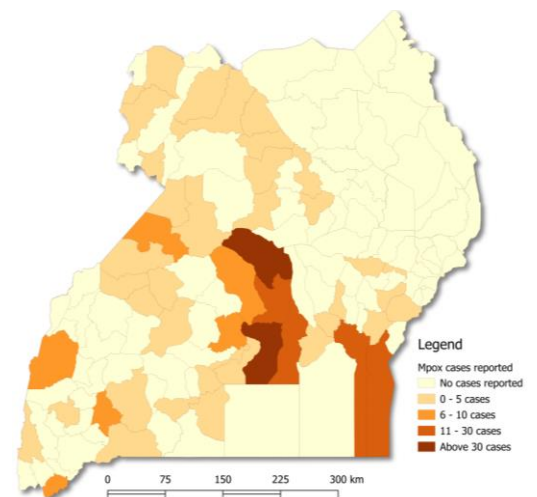
Affected districts (**48**)

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday).
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday).
3. Pillar specific meetings continue to happen weekly
4. Case investigations are being conducted for all positive cases
5. Case management bi-weekly webinars continue to happen
6. A national TOT on go-data and e-IDSR was conducted for 83 persons.
