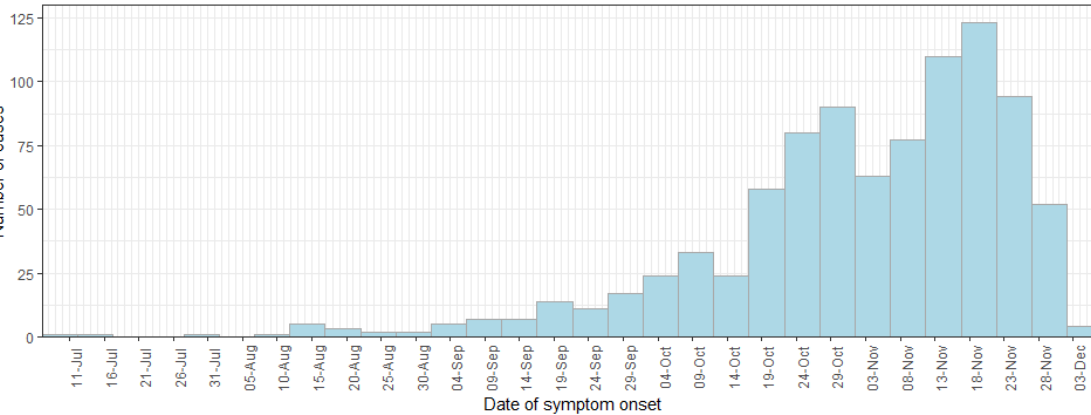

Time analysis of cases (n = 926)



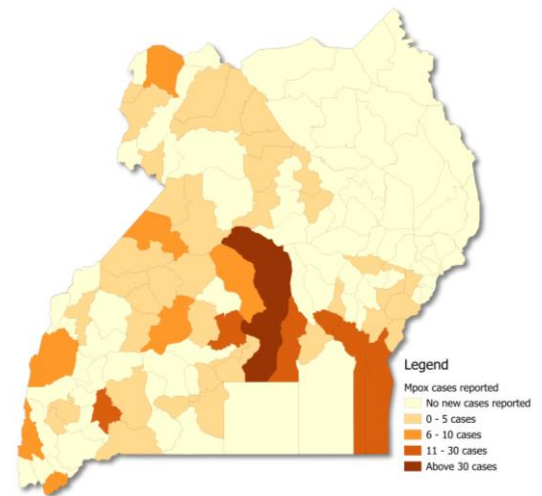
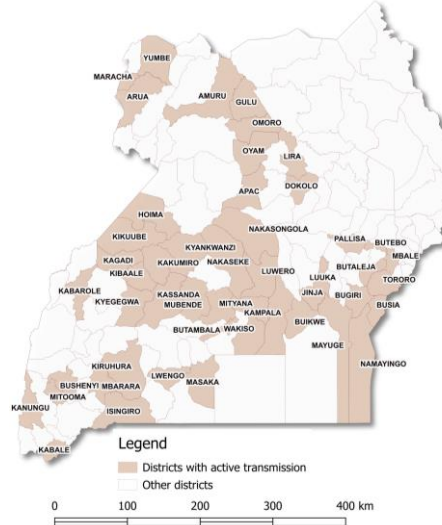
Key Highlights

- **138** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR **0.7%**
- The new case is from Namayingo district
- Majority of the cases are males **56%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **61%**
- GKMA contributes **65%** of the total case load

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday).
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday).
3. Pillar specific meetings continue to happen weekly
4. Case investigations are being conducted for all positive cases
5. Case management bi-weekly webinars continue to happen
6. HIV testing had been incorporated as part of the management package for Mpox patients
7. Surge space is being obtained to decompress Entebbe RRH isolation unit and improve quality of care
