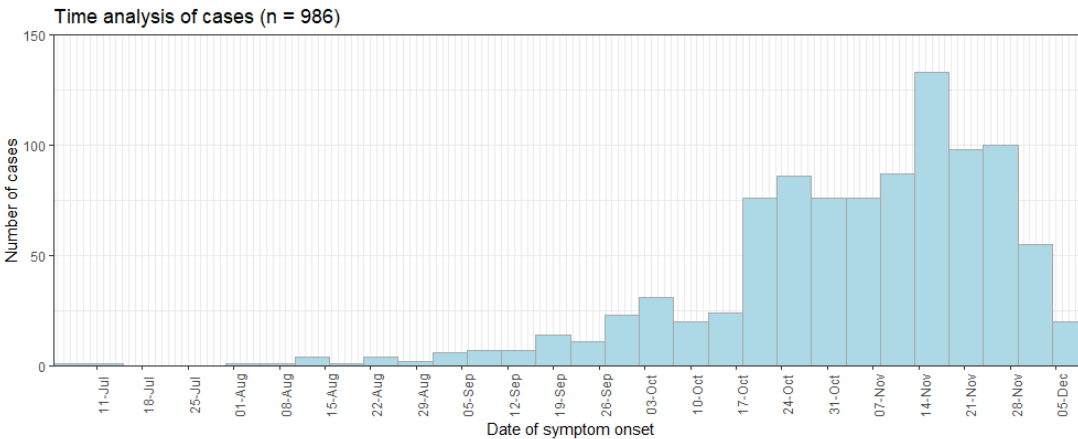

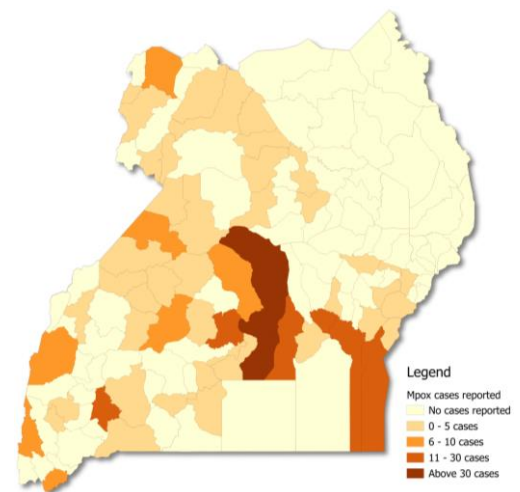
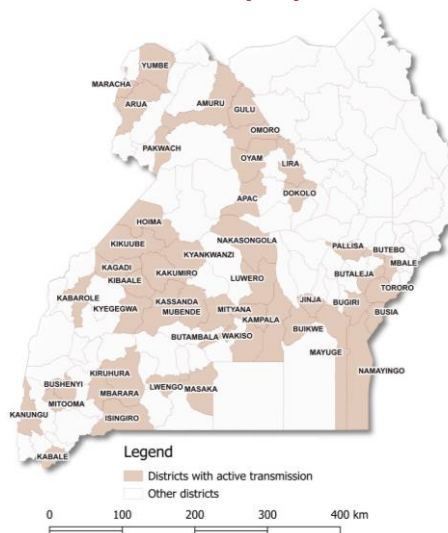
- **140** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR **0.7%**
- New cases; Kampala (**13**), Wakiso (**06**), Mbarara (**06**), Mayuge (**02**), Nakasongola (**02**), Buikwe (**01**), Jinja (**01**), Mubende (**01**), Pakwach (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **57%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **61%**
- GKMA contributes **66%** of the total case load
- Pakwach district reports an Mpox case for the first time
