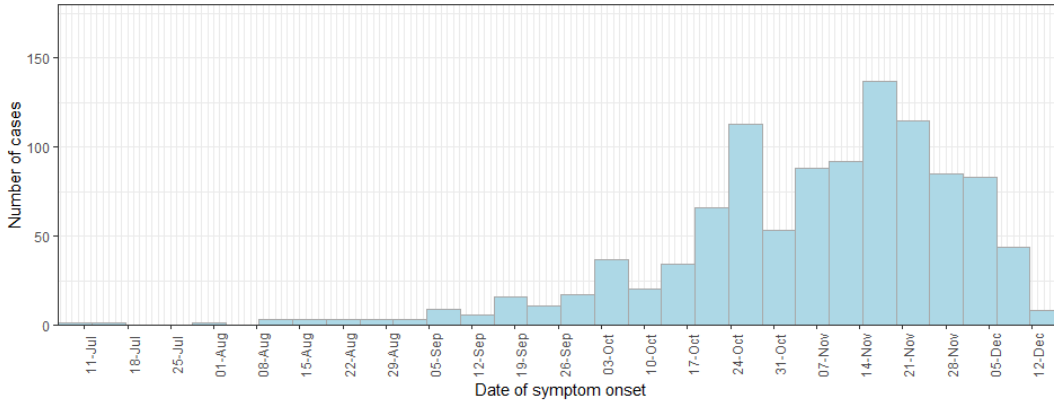

Time analysis of cases (n = 1,086)



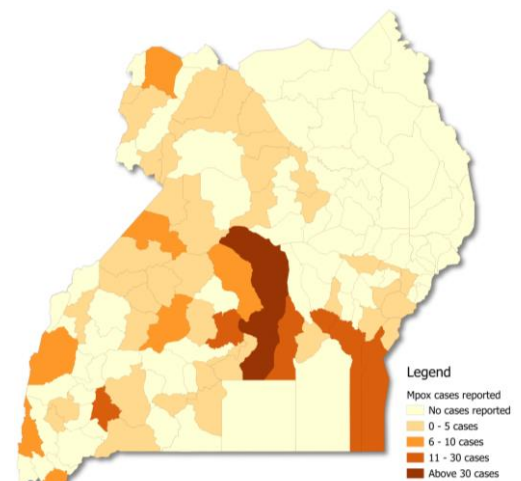
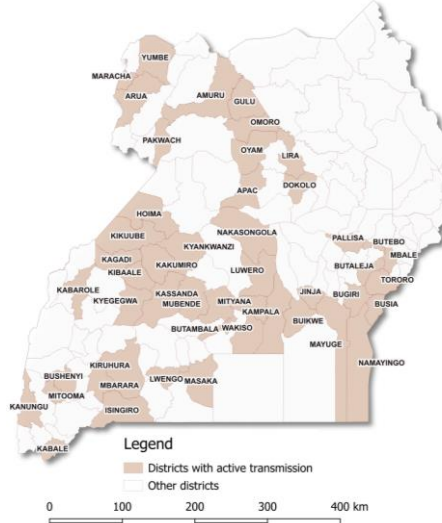
Key Highlights

- **146** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR **4%**
- New cases; Kampala (**25**), Luwero (**08**), Wakiso (**04**), Nakasongola (**02**), Mbarara (**01**), Buikwe (**01**), Amuru (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **57%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **62%**
- GKMA contributes **67%** of the total case load

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday).
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday).
3. Pillar specific meetings continue to happen weekly
4. Case investigations are being conducted for all positive cases
5. Case management bi-weekly webinars continue to happen
6. The RCCE pillar continues to analyse and leverage community feedback insights to generate messages
7. Over 70 County Sheiks were oriented about Mpox and their roles in raising awareness among their congregations and the entire community.
