



## **Key Highlights**


- 161 days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR 0.4%
- New cases; Kampala (40), Wakiso (13), Hoima (03), Mbarara (01), Buvuma (01), Iganga (01), Mukono (01), Pallisa (01), Zombo (01)
- Majority of the cases are males 58%
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected 63%
- GKMA contributes 71% of the total case load
  - Buvuma and Iganga districts reported an Mpox case for the first time since the start of the outbreak

Districts with no Mpox case reported (66)


