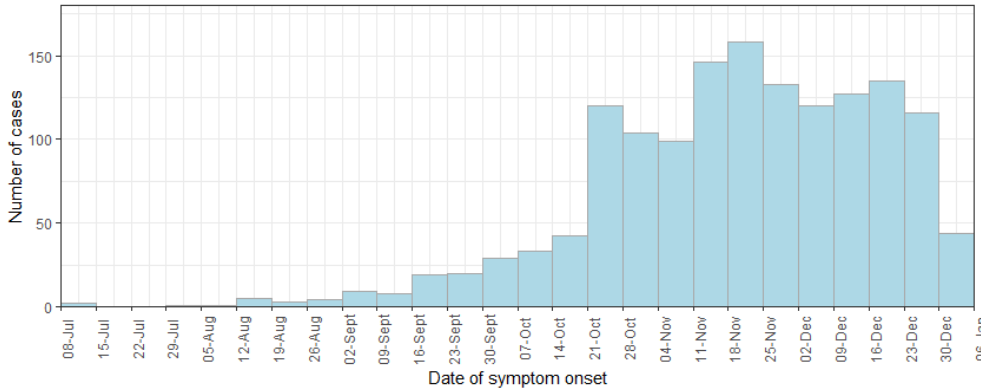

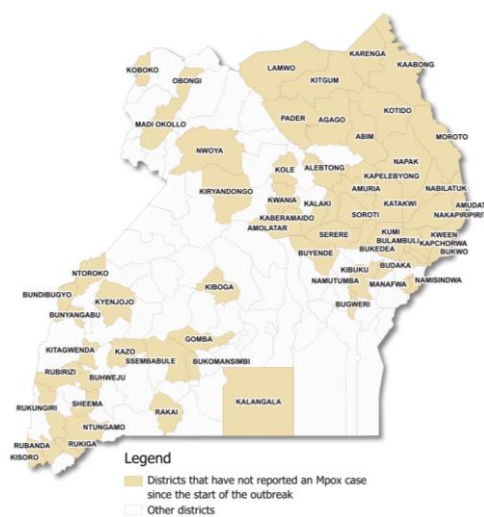
Time analysis of cases (n = 1,552)



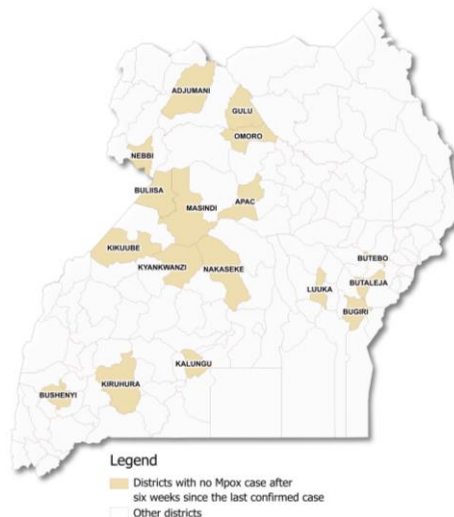
Key Highlights

- **165** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR **0.8%**
- New cases; Kampala (**21**), Mbarara (**01**), Jinja (**01**), Kanungu (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **58%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **65%**
- GKMA contributes **72%** of the total case load

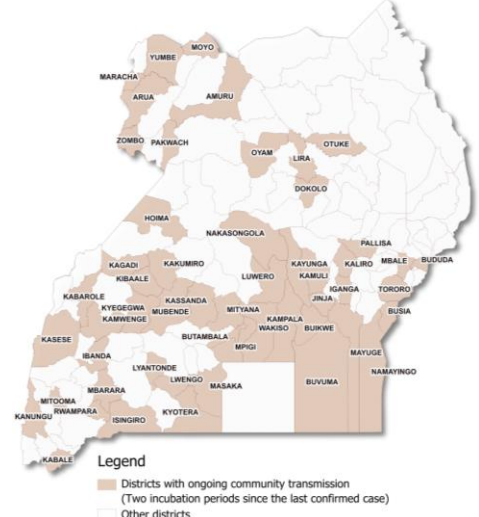
Districts with no Mpox case reported (**75**)
