


## Geographical Distribution: Maps Showing Distribution of Mpox Cases.




Mpox Cases Reported in Last 21 Days


# Person Distribution: Charts Showing Person Distribution of Mpox Cases






### Person Characteristics: Distribution of Underlying Conditions
