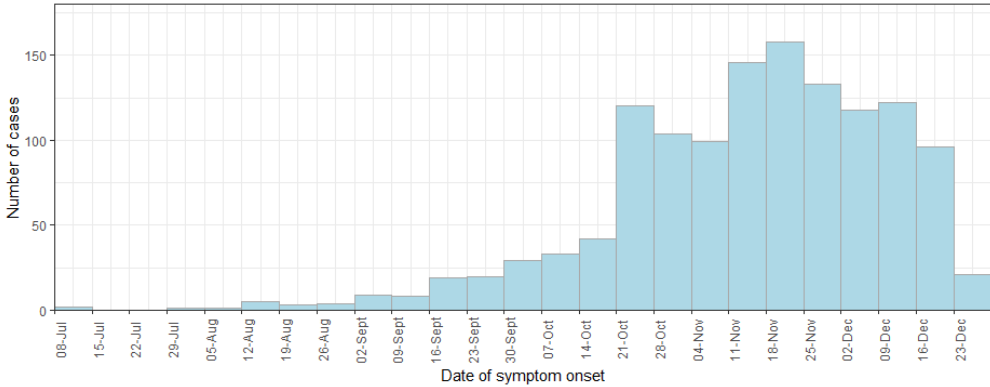

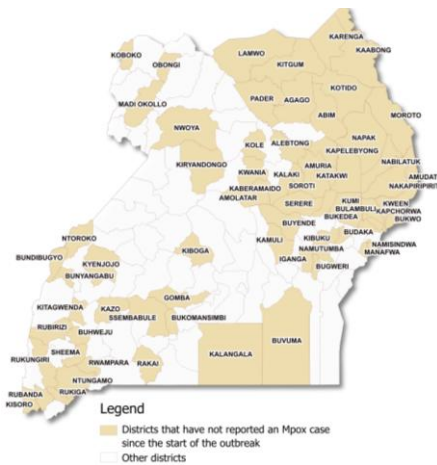
Time analysis of cases (n = 1,353)



Key Highlights

- **158** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR **0.4%**
- New cases; Kampala (**44**), Mukono (**04**), Lira (**02**), Otuke (**02**)
- Majority of the cases are males **58%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **63%**
- GKMA contributes **71%** of the total case load
- Otuke district reported an Mpox case for the first time since the start of the outbreak
- ****Two cases from Wakiso and Kampala have been dropped after reclassification**

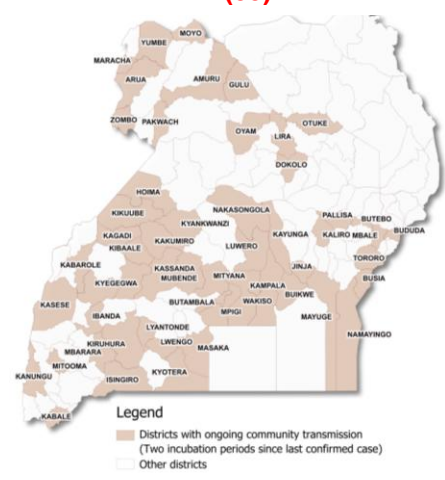
Districts with no Mpox case reported (**68**)
